Shares or equities, corporate bonds, and government bonds, treasury notes and treasury bills are traded on the ECSE. Currently listed on the ECSE are thirteen equities, corporate bonds issued by one corporate issuer, and several treasury bonds, bills and notes issued by the Governments of Antigua and Barbuda, Commonwealth of Dominica, Grenada, St Kitts-Nevis, St Lucia, and St Vincent and the Grenadines.
