On the Regional Government Securities Market, the following auctions took place using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange:

- the Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines' 91-day Treasury bill raised \$28.0 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 1.98018%.
- the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 3-year Note raised \$20.0 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used resulted in an interest rate of 6.25%.
