What does an All-Or-None order mean?

An All-Or-None order is a limited price order which is to be executed in its entirety or not at all. For example an investor may wish to buy 1,000 Domlec shares at \$4.00, however, only 600 Domlec shares are offered for sale at \$4.00. Even though the prices matched no trade will occur because the quantities do not match.
