On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 10,000 units of the Government of Saint Lucia's 10year bond, LCG100226, traded at 7.5% and 59,000 units of the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 2-year Note, AGN091021, crossed the market.

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 365-day Treasury bill auctioned on the ECSE's primary market platform raised \$10.7 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 3.84615%.
