Why do companies set record dates?

Companies set record dates to determine the official shareholders at a particular date in order to make dividend payments. For example, if the Board of Directors of Grenada Electricity Services Limited, (GRENLEC) approve the payment of dividends to shareholders on record at 7 June 2018; this means that shareholders on GRENLEC's register at the record date of 7 June 2018 will be entitled to receive dividends.
