Can I add another person's name to my Registry account?

Yes. Investors can choose to have joint accounts for holding securities. If another person is added to your account it means that they jointly own **all** the securities in that account. If you wish to add another person to your account at the Registry, an Application for Addition of Shareholder form must be completed. The form can be obtained at any Broker's office or at the ECSE's website, www.ecseonline.com.
