## What does 'good-till-cancelled' mean when referring to orders?

If you wish to buy or sell a security at a specific price, the broker enters a good-till-cancelled order, which means that the order remains in effect until the order is executed or cancelled. A good-till-cancelled order, also called an open order, is the opposite of a day order, which is automatically cancelled at the end of the trading day if it isn't filled.
