### **Summary trading report for the week ending Friday, 31 July 2020**

#### **Eastern Caribbean Securities Market**

On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market this week, 10,000 units of the Government of Saint Lucia's 10-year bond, LCG0128AA, traded at 7.25%.

#### **Regional Government Securities Market**

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the following auctions took place using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange:

- the Government of Grenada's 365-day Treasury bill raised \$25.0 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 2.20049%.
- the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 180-day Treasury bill raised \$19.5 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 3.92262%.

The next auction scheduled to be held on the Regional Government Securities Market is the Government of Saint Lucia's 180-day Treasury bill, offered at a maximum rate of 4.0% which will take place on 6 August 2020, using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange. Bidding for this auction will commence at 9:00 am and end at 12:00 pm.
