#### **Eastern Caribbean Securities Market**

This week, following a listing ceremony in St George's Grenada on 26 July 2017, the Grenada Co-operative Bank Limited became the sixteenth company to be listed on the ECSE. The Company's shares are known in the market by its trading symbol, GCBL.

#### **Regional Government Securities Market**

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the following auction took place using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange:

- the Government of The Commonwealth of Dominica's 91-day Treasury bill raised \$20.0 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 1.99008%

The next auction scheduled to be held on the Regional Government Securities Market is the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 5-year US Dollar Note, offered at a maximum rate of 7.0%, which will take place on 2 August 2017 using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange. Bidding for this auction will commence at 9:00 am and end at 12:00 pm.
