Today on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 21,541 S L Horsford & Company shares traded at \$1.65 up fifteen cents or 10% since its last traded price, 925 St Kitts Nevis Anguilla National Bank shares traded at \$3.28 unchanged since it last market close and 50,000 Bank of Nevis shares traded at \$6.00 up seventy-five cents or 14.29% since its last traded price. Although there were bids and offers for other listed securities there were no other matches, and thus there were no other changes in the market prices of the securities trading on the ECSM.
