



ECSE DAILY TRADE REPORT

Welcome to the ECSE daily trading report for 3rd January 2008.

Today on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 20 St Kitts Nevis and Anguilla National Bank shares traded at \$3.30 and 20 Trinidad Cement Limited shares traded at \$3.55 both unchanged since their last traded price and 1,625 shares of Dominica Electricity Services Limited traded at \$3.48 down one cent or 0.29% since the last market close.

Also, on the Regional Government Securities Market, the Government of Antigua and Barbuda 91-day EC\$17 million treasury bill issue was oversubscribed. A total of 14 bids were entered by six brokerage firms ranging from 15,000 to 5,000,000 with an aggregate value of \$17,166,000. The brokerage firms of ABI Bank Ltd, Antigua Commercial Bank, National Commercial Bank (SVG) Ltd, Caribbean Money Market Brokers Limited, National Bank of Anguilla Ltd, and National Mortgage and Finance Company of Dominica Ltd participated in this auction.
