#### **How is a stock dividend paid?**

Corporations may pay dividends in the form of stock rather than cash. For example, if ECFH pays a stock dividend of 4-for-20, this means that for every twenty shares owned the shareholder will be given 4 additional shares. So for example, a shareholder who previously owned 100 ECFH shares will now own 120 ECFH shares.
