What is meant by facilitation in a securities market?

In a securities market facilitation is the process of providing a mechanism for trading securities. The ECSE is the facilitator for the buying and selling of equities, corporate debt and government debt. Currently available for trading on the ECSE are 9 listed equities, 5 corporate bonds, 9 government treasury bills and 21 government bonds.
