Today on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 1,414 St Kitts Nevis and Anguilla National Bank shares traded at \$3.30 unchanged since its last market close. Although there were bids and offers for other listed securities there were no other matches, and thus there were no changes in the market prices of the securities trading on the ECSM.

And today's financial tip:

My husband recently died. How do I remove his name from our joint account at the Registry?

In a joint account situation where one of the holders is deceased, the surviving holder is now sole owner or beneficiary of the securities. The beneficiary holder is required to submit a completed notarised copy of the Transfer on Death request form to the registry, with notarised copies of the deceased death certificate and the beneficiary's id (eg. drivers' license or social security card).
