Welcome to the ECSE daily trading report for 24th August 2007.

Today on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market the following securities traded: 100 shares of Bank of Nevis at \$5.50 per share, holding firm on its previous market close, 70,000 units of the Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines' 91 day treasury bill, VCB201107 at 5.82% and 461,000 units of the Government of St. Lucia's 10 year bond, LCG100116 at 6.50%. Although there were bids and offers for other listed securities there were no other matches and thus there were no changes in the market prices of the securities trading on the ECSM.

And today's financial tip:

Will the registry accept a request to change the details of my account without verifying that I made the request?

No, the Registry always verifies that the holder of the account is the person requesting a change. The account information maintained by the registry is legal proof of your holdings so in order to effect any changes the registry requires legal proof, such as certification by a notary public or broker dealer, that the request is being made by you.
