On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market today, 5,207 Dominica Electricity Services shares traded at \$2.99, an increase of four cents or 1.36 per cent.

Also, the Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines' \$20 million Treasury bill issue, auctioned on the Regional Government Securities Market using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange was oversubscribed by \$1.75 million. A uniform price auction methodology was used and the resulting discount rate was 5.50 per cent.
