### **And today's financial tip:**

#### **I have a joint account and I want to remove the other person's name from the account. How do I do this?**

There are three ways in which you may remove someone's name from your joint account:

1. All holders of the account sign the form requesting that the person's name be removed from the account; in other words the person being removed would have to agree to the removal of their name from the account;
2. Provide the Registry with a valid Court Order stating that the shares now belong solely to you;
3. If the person is dead you complete a Transfer on Death form and submit proof that the person is deceased.
