## What is the difference between a registered bond and a coupon bond?

A bond where the holders' names are officially recorded is a registered bond. That official record (also called a register) determines ownership rights, like the payment of interest. A coupon bond, on the other hand, is a bearer instrument; whoever holds the physical certificate is presumed to be the owner.
