#### **Why does the exchange rate for the Pound change but not for the US Dollar?**

The Eastern Caribbean Dollar is fixed at an exchange rate of 2.7 to 1 US Dollar, so the exchange rate between the EC Dollar and the US Dollar never changes. However, the exchange rate between the EC Dollar and the Pound; and the US Dollar and the Pound is not fixed and as a result the rate changes daily.
