## Can I add another person's name to my Registry account?

Yes. Investors can choose to have joint accounts for holding securities. It is important to remember that different types of securities can be held in the same Registry account, and if another person is added to your account it means that they jointly own <u>all</u> the securities in that account. If you wish to add another person to your account at the Registry, an Addition of Holder form must be completed. The form will all instructions and documentation required can be obtained at any Broker's office or at the ECSE's website, www.ecseonline.com.
