Today on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 100 Bank of Nevis shares traded at \$5.50, an increase of thirty five cents or 6.80% on its previous market close. Although there were bids and offers for other listed securities there were no other matches and thus there were no other changes in the market prices of the securities trading on the ECSM.

### **And today's financial tip:**

#### **I hold several joint and single accounts – can I consolidate my accounts into one?**

Registry accounts can only be consolidated under the following circumstances.

1. If the accounts are single, meaning your name only is registered on the account, they can be consolidated into one account.
2. If they are joint accounts with the same names registered on the accounts then they can also be consolidated into one account.
3. However, to consolidate joint accounts held in different names, you must first ensure that the same names are registered on all the accounts by adding the missing names. The same is done to consolidate single accounts into joint accounts. Please note that the other holders now have a right to all your securities and their consent is required for any dealings in the securities.
