What is meant by facilitation in a securities market?

In a securities market facilitation is the process of providing a mechanism for trading securities. The ECSE is the facilitator for the buying and selling of equities, corporate debt and government debt. Currently available for trading on the ECSE are 13 listed equities, 4 corporate bonds, 9 government treasury bills, 27 government bonds and 4 notes.
