My husband recently died. How do I remove his name from our joint account at the Registry?

In a joint account situation where one of the holders is deceased, the surviving holder is now sole owner or beneficiary of the securities. The beneficiary holder is required to submit a completed notarised copy of the Transfer on Death request form to the registry, with notarised copies of the deceased death certificate and the beneficiary's id (eg. drivers' license or social security card).
