On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market today, 5,000 Bank of Nevis shares traded at \$6.10, up ten cents or 1.67% on its last traded price.

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the Government of Saint Lucia's \$19 million 91-day Treasury bill auctioned on the primary platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange was over-subscribed by \$270,000. A competitive uniform price auction methodology was used and the resulting discount rate was 6.00%.

The Eastern Caribbean Central Securities Registry holds the ownership records for all securities listed on the ECSE. Therefore, every investor owning any of those securities is assigned a registry account. The registry account may also hold multiple securities.
