And today's financial tip:

What is the difference between a single account and a joint account at the Registry?

A single account has one person's name as the holder and is the sole owner of the securities held in that account, while a joint account has two or more person's names as the account's holders or co-owners. The holder of a single account is the sole owner of securities held on that account and may sell or otherwise deal in those securities, while the holders of a joint account are coowners with equal rights to the securities held in that account and decisions to deal in the securities must be unanimous.
