If my parents held a joint account with me do I have to submit two transfer on death request forms to remove their names or can one form be used?

Because both of the deceased were holders of the account one transfer on death request form is acceptable. However, the names of the deceased should be clearly stated on the form. In this instance a certified copy of each parent's death certificate, the certified transfer on death form and a certified copy the beneficiary's ID are the only documents required to effect the transfer on death request.
