## And today's financial tip:

## If I can't attend my company's AGM can I send someone to represent me?

Yes, all shareholders entitled to attend a company's Annual General Meeting may designate someone to act as their representative if they are unable to attend – but you must complete a proxy form, which identifies the representative and gives them the authority to vote on your behalf. The proxy will only be valid if it is deposited with the company in advance of the AGM. In most cases, companies require that the proxy form be deposited at least 48 hours before the date and time of the meeting.
