Summary trading report for the week ending Friday, 1 February 2008

Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

This week on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market the following trades took place, 75 Dominica Electricity Services shares traded at \$3.45, and 200 East Caribbean Financial Holding Company shares traded at \$15.00, both holding firm on their last trading price. Also, 101,000 units of the Government of Antigua and Barbuda 7-year US dollar bond traded at 8.00%.

Regional Government Securities Market

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the Government of Antigua and Barbuda will auction a \$17.0 million 91-day treasury bill on Tuesday, February 5th 2008. Bidding for the auction begins at 9:00 am and ends and 12:00 noon using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange.
