In what was an active week on the Regional Government Securities Market (RGSM) two OECS Governments auctioned Treasury Bills. On Monday 12th The Government of Grenada was successful in raising \$25million in the form of a 365-day Treasury Bill. The execution price for the T-Bill was \$95 for every \$100 nominal. The Government St. Vincent and the Grenadines auction another in its series of 91-day EC\$16,000,000 Bills on Friday 16th July. The execution price for this T-Bill was \$98.94 for every \$100 nominal.

Finally, at the recently held Annual General Meeting of Grenada Electricity Services Limited (GRENLEC) shareholders granted approval to have the shares of GRENLEC listed on the ECSE. Plans are now being finalised to have the company listed within the next two months.

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
