Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> August will see the Dominica Electricity Services Limited (Domlec) become the fifth company to have its shares listed on the ECSE. Domlec will be the second utility company to be listed, it's listing closely following that of Lucelec - its St. Lucian Counterpart.
