Does the depository account statement state the number of shares owned?

Yes, the number of shares owned is detailed on the depository account statement. The column labeled 'quantity' details the total number of shares the shareholder holds as at the date of the statement. For example a statement sent to John Jones dated June 20, 2021 might show a quantity of 10,000 Bank of Nevis shares. This means that on June 20 Mr Jones owned a total of 10,000 Bank of Nevis shares.
