How will I know the balance on my account after I have successfully bought shares?

After a successful trade the broker will inform the buying investor of his/her success. Shortly after settlement on the following day, the broker will transfer the securities into the investors' account. The Eastern Caribbean Central Securities Registry records the activity and mails out an account activity statement the morning after the transfer. The statement provides details of the transfer and the new account balance.
