**Will the registry accept a request to change the details of my account without verifying that I made the request?**

No, the Registry always verifies that the holder of the account is the person requesting a change. The account information maintained by the registry is legal proof of your holdings so to effect any changes the registry requires legal proof, such as certification by a notary public or broker dealer, that the request is being made by you.
