Summary trading report for the week ending Friday, 20 January 2023

Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

The following trades took place on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market this week:

- 11,500 TDC Ltd shares traded at \$1.30 per share unchanged from its last traded price
- 375 S.L. Horsfords & Co Ltd shares traded at \$2.00 per share unchanged from its last traded price
- 283 S.L. Horsfords & Co Ltd shares traded odd lot at \$2.00 per share
- 1,079 Grenada Electricity Company Ltd traded at \$10.95 per share rising 0.45 cents or
 4.3% from its last traded price
- 950 units of Grenada Co-operative Bank Ltd traded at \$9.00 per share, rising 0.12 cents or 1.4% from its last traded price
- 160 units of Grenada Co-operative Bank Ltd traded at \$9.00 per share, unchanged from its last traded price
- 426 units of Grenada Electricity Company Ltd traded at \$11.00 per share, rising 0.05 cents or 0.46% from its last traded price and
- 85 units of Grenada Co-operative Bank Ltd traded odd lot at a low of \$8.88 and a high of \$9.00 per share.

Regional Government Securities Market

The following issues were auctioned on the Regional Government Securities Market this week:

- Government of Saint Lucia's 180-day Treasury-bill auctioned on January 18th on the ECSE's primary market platform, raised \$25.0 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 3.44061%.
- The Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 180-day Treasury-bill auctioned on January 20th on the ECSE's primary market platform, raised \$17.3 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 3.92262%.

The next auction scheduled to be held on the Regional Government Securities Market is the Government of the Grenada's 91-day Treasury-bill offered at maximum rate of 3.5% which will take place on 25 January 2023, using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange. Bidding for this auction will commence at 9:00 am and end at 12:00 pm.
